Playwright Augusto Federico Amador



Augusto Federico Amador is one of the rising Latinx playwrights in America. His play, *Atacama*, will be given its area premiere by Full Circle Theater in 2022, and was selected for Steppenwolf Theatre's The Mix List of plays featuring casts of intersectional and intersecting social identities. Mr. Amador's plays have been produced across the country at venues including The Public Theater (NYC), San Diego Repertory Theatre, Los Angeles Theater Center, Teatro Paraguas in Santa Fe, and the National Hispanic Cultural Center in Albuquerque. His original TV pilot, 86'd, is currently in development with Wise Entertainment for a first look at Amazon Studios

Mr. Amador's plays have been finalists for several prestigious awards, including the Terrence McNally Award, the BBC International Radio Playwriting Competition, and the National Latino Playwriting Award from the Arizona Theater Company. His playwriting fellowships include: The Public Theater in NYC, The Humanitas Prize in Los Angeles, the Latino Theater Alliance/L.A., and the Lincoln City Fellowship in NYC.

Mr. Amador was born and raised in Silicon Valley and is the son of a Peruvian father (music composer) and an Austrian mother (culinary chef). Augusto's previous careers include: coffee house proprietor, car salesman, assistant tile setter, running numbers for a bookie, and of course, long suffering waiter. Lara Trujillo, Full Circle Theater Core Artist, is a vocalist, actor, educator and director, and has served as music director for productions ranging from light opera to classic musical theater. As a performer she has appeared with the Minnesota Opera; The Gilbert & Sullivan Very Light Opera Company; Mu Performing Arts; Chanhassen Dinner Theater; Teatro del Pueblo; Theater Latte Da; Flying Foot Forum; Mill City Summer Opera; History Theater, most recently in *River Road Boogie: The Augie Garcia Story*; and the Ordway Center, most recently *In In the Heights*. She co-wrote Full Circle Theater Company's initial production of *Theater: A Sacred Passage*. Lara co-directed Full Circle Theater Company's staging of *365 Days/365 Plays*, in directorial collaboration with Full Circle's Artistic Leadership team, and directed Full Circle's initial staged reading of *Atacama* in 2018.

Pedro R. Bayon is making his Full Circle Theatre debut. He recently played King Basilio for Pangea World Theatre's production of *Sueño*, at The Lab Theatre. Recent productions include: *Neighbors*, at the History Theatre; *The Sins of Sor Juana*, at Ten Thousand Things; and *In The Heights*, at The Ordway Center for the Arts. Some of his other credits include Mixed Blood Theatre (*Minnecanos*, *Elemeno Pea*, *Safe At Home*, *Quinceañera*, *The Pajama Game*, among others), History Theatre (*River Road Boogie: The Augie Garcia Story*, *To Kill a Mockingbird*, *Los Rumbaleros*), Park Square Theatre (*The House on Mango Street*, *Elliot: A Soldier's Fugue*), Frank Theatre (*Ambient Love Rites*), among others. Cristina Castro is a native of Santiago, Chile. She grew up in Chile and moved to Saint Paul, Minnesota in 1998 as a cultural exchange student. She completed her undergraduate studies in English and French at the Universidad Católica de Chile and her graduate studies in Curriculum and Instruction and Adult Education at the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis. She currently works in the Spanish and Portuguese Department at the University of Minnesota teaching language, culture, writing and Latin-American literature for heritage and non-native Spanish speakers. Cristina lives in Falcon Heights with her husband and two children. She returns to her native Chile every year to be in touch with her country and family.

Claribel Gross is a nomadic theater maker and teaching artist with a passion for languages. She has training and experience in Social Justice Theater, Devised Theater, Theater of the Oppressed, Theater for Young Audiences, Viewpoints, Playwriting, Experimental writing and Solo performance. She has a passion for new work, works in development and devising work with communities. As a performer, teaching artist and arts administrator Claribel has worked with Penumbra theatre, Teatro del Pueblo, English speaking Theater of Rome, Bedlam Theater, Pillsbury House Theater and Hamline University. Claribel holds a BA from the University of Minnesota and after several years of working in the theater obtained her MFA from Sarah Lawrence College.
